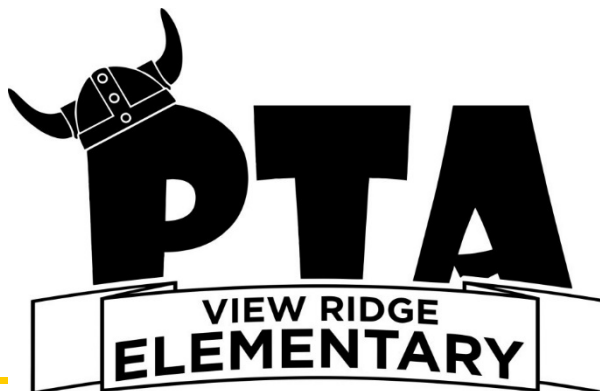

Congrats to Ms. Hils classroom for highest amount raised, you will be enjoying a pizza party soon.

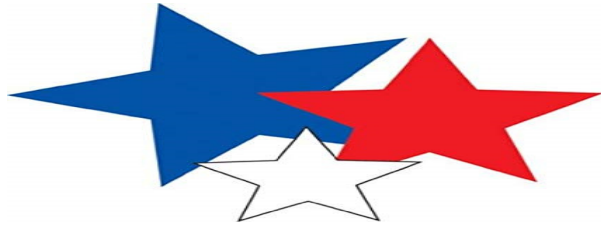
***Poinsettia & Wreath Pick up Nov. 20***

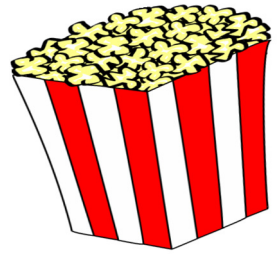
